

The PortAventura Foundation kicks off its 15th anniversary

- *Since 2011, more than 10 million euros have been allocated to social projects that have helped improve the wellbeing of over 118,000 children*

PortAventura World, April 14, 2026. This 2026, the **PortAventura Foundation** turns **15** and has kicked off the celebration with the start of the **new season at PortAventura Dreams Village**. This April, its most emblematic project once again welcomes children, young people with serious illnesses, and their families as part of their emotional therapy and recovery.

Since its founding in 2011, the PortAventura Foundation has channelled PortAventura World's social commitment through work focused on the integration of vulnerable groups, especially minors. **More than 10 million euros have been allocated to over 100 social organisations**, contributing to improving the **wellbeing of more than 118,000 children and young people**.

This positive impact has been made possible thanks to the **solid collaborative network** built with institutions, companies, hospitals and social organisations, as well as **100 active corporate volunteers**.

Throughout 2026 and under the slogan "**15 years sharing emotions**", the celebration will be specially integrated into all of the Foundation's activities and its three major annual events: the **Fun Run**, to be held on Saturday 23 and Sunday 24 May; the **Charity Dinner**, on Thursday 16 July; and the **Charity Golf Tournament**, on Saturday 14 November. The aim is

to go beyond a one-off celebration and create several moments to mark the journey since 2011.

In the words of **Josep Andreu, President of the PortAventura Foundation**: *"This 15th anniversary is an opportunity to highlight everything we have built so far, but above all to keep building for the benefit of the most vulnerable and the local community. We have seen that when emotions are shared, lives are transformed. We want each of the initiatives planned this year to help us continue sharing emotions and expand the social impact of the PortAventura Foundation."*

Among the **key milestones** in its history, notable highlights include the **launch of PortAventura Dreams Village in 2019** and the **expansion of the project in 2024**. Today, PortAventura Dreams Village has ten adapted houses, communal spaces, and a free one-week stay programme that includes access to the parks and recreational-therapeutic activities led by volunteers. Following its expansion, the project can now welcome more than 400 families per year, with **over 1,200 families** having stayed there in total since its creation.

About PortAventura Foundation

PortAventura Foundation is a non-profit organization working to promote the social integration of vulnerable or at risk groups, with a special focus on children and young people. Since its creation in 2011, it has carried out all its social initiatives within PortAventura World's ESG strategy (environmental, social and governance). Its flagship project is PortAventura Dreams Village, a pioneering initiative in Europe that offers free one-week stays in a dedicated village inside the resort to children and young people with serious illnesses and their families, as part of their emotional recovery therapy. More than 400 families stay in the village each year. The foundation also drives numerous fundraising activities for social organizations, supports solidarity events and awareness campaigns, and facilitates access to leisure for people at risk of social exclusion.
