

## PortAventura World celebrates the 8th edition of “Dialogue with suppliers” in the context of its 30th anniversary



Recognition of suppliers with over thirty years of collaboration with PortAventura World

**PortAventura World, 28 November 2025. – PortAventura World** is celebrating a new edition of “Dialogue with suppliers”, the annual event that brings together its **more than 120 highest-billing** suppliers to **share the year’s milestones**, future **strategic challenges** and **strengthen** a key **relationship** for the growth of the resort. The event is conceived as a space for close dialogue beyond the commercial relationship, highlighting the fundamental role that the supply chain plays in achieving the company’s objectives.

The invited suppliers include **companies from sectors such as services, technology, food, logistics, maintenance, construction and digital solutions**, reflecting the diversity and operational complexity of a leading resort in Europe.

As part of PortAventura World’s 30th anniversary, this edition includes **a special recognition of the more than thirty suppliers that have been collaborating with the company for three decades**, underlining the importance of building long-term relationships based on mutual trust and joint evolution. An average of **1,430 suppliers per year**, **64% of which are from Catalonia**, and **€116M in average annual billing**, with 68% of it from Catalonia. In addition, half of the company’s main suppliers have been



with them **for over 15 years**, and **more than 30** have worked with the resort **continuously for 30 years**. A list that is joined by **49 sponsors over 30 years**, with an **average of 10 years** working together, 25 of whom were also sponsors in 2024.

During the event, the top-rated suppliers of the year in various **service and supply** categories are also announced, as well as the most outstanding initiatives in sustainability, digitalisation/innovation, and occupational risk prevention.

The awards, which assess management in 2024, are granted to the following companies: **Sabico** (In Resort Services), **Microbio** (Non-Presential Services) and **Spatial Voyagers** (Digitalisation and Innovation). In strategic initiatives, awards go to **Distribuciones Hermanos García (DHG)** for Sustainability and to **Moncobra** for Occupational Risk Prevention. In the Supplies category, **Barcelonesa Group** and **Sonepar** are recognised in the with and without distribution (in Resort) categories, respectively.

**Fernando Aldecoa, Managing Director of PortAventura World**, highlights that *“our suppliers are an essential part of our daily work and of the path we are taking towards the future. This event reflects our commitment to listening, sharing and growing together, especially in such a symbolic year as our 30th anniversary.”*

As a benchmark resort in Europe and a B Corp certified company, **PortAventura World works with the purpose of generating a positive impact on people and their environment**, integrating sustainability, innovation and economic development into its global strategy. “Dialogue with suppliers” is part of this vision and is integrated within the **“PortAventura Dialogues”** initiative, which aims to promote **transparency and collaboration** with the resort’s key stakeholders.
