

## PortAventura Foundation consolidates its social commitment to the region with its 14th Charity Dinner

**PortAventura World, July 18, 2025** – The **PortAventura Foundation** has held the fourteenth edition of its Charity Dinner, an event that has once again established itself as a benchmark for solidarity and a driving force for social impact in the region. The evening brought together more than 1,200 attendees, including prominent institutional representatives such as the Delegate of the Government, the mayors of Salou and Vila-Seca, among others; as well as social institutions, collaborating companies, and friends of the Foundation.

This year's edition has donated a total of €125,550 to support various entities in the region: **Fundació La Muntanyeta**, with the project for its **new residence**, a pioneering complex organized in living units, which will allow for comprehensive, continuous, and personalized care for people with cerebral palsy and multiple disabilities; the **Enriqueta Villavecchia Private Foundation for Child Oncology**, to promote its project "**Pavilion of Victory**", a pioneering space that seeks to provide a warm, welcoming environment with specialized care within the hospital, but away from the usual clinical atmosphere for children and young people with cancer or serious illnesses; and the **Dreams Village** by PortAventura Foundation, which offers **a unique recovery space for families with children and young people with serious illnesses**, inviting them to enjoy an all-inclusive week at the resort and promoting leisure as a key tool in their recovery process.

Under the motto "**A night that embraces many lives**", it was an especially emotional evening as it marked the last event for **Ramon Marsal** as **President of the**



**PortAventura Foundation**, a position he has held since the Foundation's inception in 2011. In the words of Ramon Marsal: *"Since its inception, the PortAventura Foundation has demonstrated that the true power of leisure lies in its ability to generate a positive impact on people. It has been an honor to be part of this journey from the beginning, collaborating with various entities and witnessing how projects like Dreams Village can change the lives of people and their families."*

The evening, hosted by **presenter Enric Company**, included emotionally charged moments where attendees were able to enjoy special highlights such as **the impressions by comedian Edu Mutante**, a **performance by the children's choir from Escola Pereanton in Granollers**—winners of the children's rights anthem contest organized this year by the Síndic de Greuges—and an excerpt from the show *"Un Viaje Fascinante"* by PortAventura World. Additionally, a charity raffle was held during the event, with numerous prizes awarded to participating attendees, as well as the **auction of an FC Barcelona jersey, delivered and signed by Gavi, Pedri, Lewandowski, and the rest of the team** during their visit to Dreams Village.

The PortAventura Foundation Charity Dinner was supported by companies and institutions. Booster Audiovisual Solutions and Transgourmet joined the event organizers as main collaborators, along with other partners such as Café Saula, Caixabank, Coca-Cola, Codorníu, Elecnor, Familia Torres, Fundación LA LIGA, GICSA, Mas La Boella, Moncobra S.A., Urbaser, and Xocosave.

With the celebration of this fourteenth Charity Dinner, the PortAventura Foundation reaffirms its **commitment to social inclusion and the well-being of vulnerable people**, especially children and young people, promoting cooperation with companies and entities that share common values to move forward together and amplify the impact on people's lives.
