

The PortAventura Foundation Charity Golf Tournament returns for another year and raises 10,240 euros for two local entities

For another year, the **PortAventura Foundation** has held its **Charity Golf Tournament**, one of its most important annual events, whose objective is to **raise funds for charity projects of local entities aimed at children and teenagers**. At this ninth edition, **120 golfers** of all levels participated, and **10,240 euros** was raised.

These funds will be allocated, firstly, to **Ceepsir Escola Solc**, specifically for the "Help-me, Ayúdame" programme for communication and social skills and the "Pequeñas miradas, grandes aprendizajes" programme for students with ASD (Autism Spectrum Disorder); and secondly, to the 12/18 project of the **Mossèn Frederic Bara Cortiella Foundation**, a social-educational assistance service for teenagers and young people in situations of social risk. This service has the purpose of assisting minors in situations of risk, promoting their personal development, social integration and learning, preventing and avoiding the deterioration of risk situations and making up for social-educational deficits.

Additionally, the **young people of these entities** and a group from **Obra Social la Caixa** were able to enjoy a **beginners' golf session** which consisted of an introduction class led by specialised professionals, who taught them the basic movements of the swing, among other

common strokes. Ultimately, it was a unique opportunity to visit a golf course for the first time and learn about this sport.

During the sports event, **Ramón Marsal, President of the PortAventura Foundation**, highlighted that *"Year after year we have consolidated our unmissable sports event for golf lovers in our region. Gathering once again for a charity cause that has a direct impact on the region around us fills us with pride, and its great reception motivates us to continue working to benefit children and young people."*

The tournament was held at the Infinitum Golf facilities, in a setting of incomparable natural interest. The participants played in two-person scramble format, teeing off from 9:30am, enjoying the game on an 18 hole golf course designed by Greg Norman. Additionally, breakfast and a cocktail were offered. The day ended with the prize ceremony and a prize draw with great gifts.

About the PortAventura Foundation

The PortAventura Foundation is a non-profit organization that works to achieve the integration into society of groups at risk of exclusion or vulnerable, with special attention to children and teenagers. Since its creation in 2011, it has been driving all actions framed in the social sphere of PortAventura World's ESG (environmental, social and good governance) strategy. Its flagship project is PortAventura Dreams, a pioneering initiative in Europe that offers free oneweek stays in a village within a resort to children and teenagers with serious illnesses and their families, as part of their emotional and recovery therapy. More than 200 families stay in the village every year. Likewise, the PortAventura Foundation promotes numerous activities to raise funds for organizations with social purposes, supports the development of solidarity and awareness-raising events and programs, and facilitates access to leisure for people at risk of social exclusion.
