

## Six organizations in the region will receive grants thanks to PortAventura Foundation's charity events

*For the second consecutive year, the goal has been to support the development of projects aimed at the most vulnerable children and adolescents.*

**PortAventura World, March 18, 2025 - PortAventura Foundation** has announced the six beneficiary organizations selected in **its second call for aid**. Priority was given to initiatives that have a **positive impact on vulnerable children and adolescents**, especially those carried out in **the counties of Tarragona**.

To mark the announcement, **Ramon Marsal, president of PortAventura Foundation**, stated: *"We firmly believe that every child and adolescent deserves the necessary opportunities to ensure a better future. With our flagship project, PortAventura Dreams Village, we see every day how small gestures can change lives. We are especially proud of these grants, as they demonstrate our support for local associations that work tirelessly to offer hope to children at risk of social exclusion."*

Each year, PortAventura Foundation organizes three major charity events: the **'Fun Run'** race, which last year gathered over 1,500 participants and will be held again on **May 25**; the traditional **Charity Dinner**, now in its 14th edition on July 24; and the **Charity Golf Tournament**, which will reach its **10th edition** this autumn. The aid will be distributed based on the profits generated from these **charity events**, thanks to the support of both **participants** and **sponsors**.

### **Beneficiary organizations of the second call for aid**

#### **From the 'Fun Run'**

- **Fundación Soñar Despierto**. Aims to improve the academic and relational situation of minors in situations of social vulnerability, especially those living in shelters, residential



centers, and open centers in the province of Tarragona. The project focuses on academic support and leisure activities to prevent school dropout and promote social integration.

- **Fundación Diagrama.** Provides psychological care to children and adolescents connected to Fundación Diagrama in Tarragona through a comprehensive psychotherapeutic intervention, which includes acquiring sensory stimulation furniture, specifically a portable Snoezelen kit.

#### **From the Charity Dinner**

- **Fundació La Muntanyeta.** Offers essential services to children with cerebral palsy. The project will equip the multisensory classroom and the music therapy workshop rooms with the necessary furniture and materials.
- **Fundació d'Oncologia Infantil Enriqueta Villavecchia.** Provides respite, rest, leisure, and family support spaces for pediatric oncology patients, as well as an appropriate environment for end-of-life accompaniment.

#### **Del Torneo de golf Solidario**

- **Associació Jeroni de Moragas.** Creates a 100% accessible space specifically designed for people with mobility issues, ensuring full inclusion and participation. The space will be divided into different zones designed to offer a complete multisensory experience, stimulating the five senses and promoting contact with nature.
- **Associación Contra el Càncer en Tarragona.** Implements a new oncology physiotherapy unit to provide a renewed approach to this service, regardless of the type of cancer or the age of the patient.

#### **About the PortAventura Foundation**

The PortAventura Foundation is a non-profit organisation that works to achieve the integration into society of groups at risk of exclusion or vulnerable, with special attention to children and young people. Since its creation in 2011, it has been the vehicle for all the actions framed in the social sphere of PortAventura World's ESG (environmental, social and good governance) strategy. Its flagship project is PortAventura Dreams, a pioneering initiative in Europe that offers free one-week stays in a village within a resort to children and young people with serious illnesses and their families, as part of their emotional and recovery therapy. More than 400 families stay in the village every year. The PortAventura Foundation also promotes numerous activities to raise funds for organisations with social purposes, supports the development of solidarity and awareness-raising events and programmes and facilitates access to leisure for people at risk of social exclusion.

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
