

The 'second summer' trend comes to life at PortAventura World: September is the new August

PortAventura World, 21 August 2025.- September is no longer a month of return, but a destination in itself: the perfect setting for those who want to squeeze the summer until the last ray of sunshine. The '**second summer**' trend – the idea of extending holidays beyond the traditional calendar – grows year after year and rewrites the way we travel: golden afternoon light, milder temperatures, and a relaxed pace that invites us to enjoy every plan as if it were the first of the holiday.

In this new summer map, **PortAventura World** is the winning combination, with three parks open in September to choose a different plan every day: **the adrenaline and entertainment of PortAventura Park, with its iconic rides and shows, the speed of Ferrari Land, and the freshness of Caribe Aquatic Park**, which remains open until the end of the month to keep celebrating the most refreshing summer under the Mediterranean sun – all in a privileged

setting by the sea. An “all-in-one” that brings together leisure, beach and relaxation without compromise.

The ‘second summer’ here tastes like slow strolls through the Far West, getting lost in Polynesia, or a sunset in Mediterrània that becomes a memory. It is best enjoyed with an integrated accommodation ecosystem: six four- and five-star themed hotels inside the resort, such as **Hotel Gold River** and **Hotel Mansion de Lucy**, and a complementary offer with **Ponient Hotels by PortAventura World**, strategically located near the beaches of Salou and in Vila-seca, for those who want to combine park days with time by the sea. In total, nearly 3,300 rooms to design a tailor-made getaway, whether with family, as a couple or with friends.

Moreover, every day at PortAventura World ends with excitement: **FiestAventura 30th Anniversary**, the grand nighttime show over the Mediterrània lake, which this year incorporates drones into its mix of water, light and music – acting as the great closing ritual of the day. And as a summer-exclusive extension, the **Moonride Music Nights** add their final two dates to the calendar: 30 August and 6 September, with the park open until 1:00 a.m., themed entertainment in each world, and musical styles ranging from DJs to live music.
